I notice that some of the Nobile dendrobiums are showing signs of budding with the little nubbins popping on the sides of the stem. If you have them and haven't dropped the temperature on them, you need to do so now. It only takes a 10-15 degree drop to start the blooming process. It takes about 30 days of the cold to bring them into bloom.


